The applicant must be already accepted into a union accredited pre-apprenticeship or apprenticeship program and/or an accredited technical college. All applications for the Trade Scholarship must be submitted by Friday, March 27, 2020 and the winners will be announced at the banquet on June 6, 2020. Each scholarship recipient winner and two guests shall be provided, at no cost, tickets to the banquet at which they will receive their scholarship.
